Daikin Applied (UK) shall consider the concerns and suggestions of all expressed interested parties and use suppliers who demonstrate environmental concern through our Green Procurement Policy.

The business will strive to reduce consumption of energy in our operations and reuse rather than dispose whenever possible. Daikin Applied (UK) will aim to be a base to achieve zero CO2 emissions based on the Daikin Environmental Vision 2050 and promote recycling through our waste management partner.


